It is great to see everyone back and ready to start a new year at Robert le Kyng.

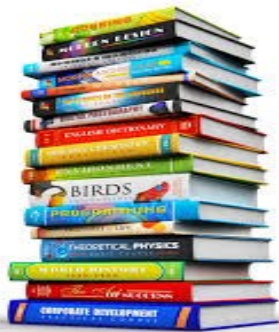
The children have already settled into their new classes.
