
Premises Update

You may well have noticed that we have had some developments to our premises this year. The outside classrooms in Foundation Stage have both had their flooring replaced with a new, bright blue flooring. These rooms will soon be up and running again for the children to use again.

In addition, we have replaced a section of fencing in the Foundation Stage Area which runs alongside the pathway. We are really pleased with how this is both safer and makes the area look much neater.

A project that the school has been working on for sometime is the replacement of the main school gates. We have concerns over the number of parents who are trying to come into the school car park and the speed at which some vehicles enter. For pupil and staff safety, no parents should be coming into this area at drop off or pick up times unless they have a blue disabled badge.

We are really pleased to announce that we are now at a stage where over the Easter holidays contractors will be placing the gate with a new automated gate. This gate will be closed at drop off and pick up and will only be opened via a buzzer to the school office for authorised access. Due to the placement of the gate, the pedestrian pathway into school at this point will be changing position to run behind the gate. Staff will be present at the entrance when the gate has been installed so that we can show you the pathway to walk in. If you can, we fully recommend walking to school as often with the traffic in Swindon this can be quicker! If at any times you see any areas of the premises that are damaged please can this be reported to the school office. Thanks for your help!
