As we no longer have a school crossing patrol man, please can you use one of the two pedestrian crossings when trying to cross the main road. Thank you



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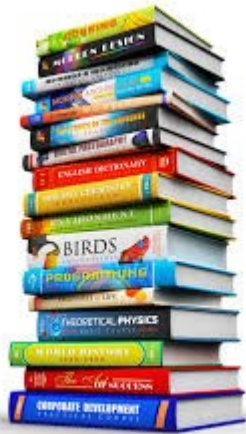
Summer Reading Challenge
