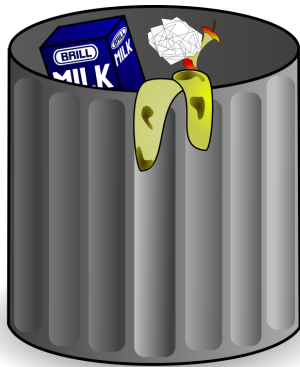

Year 2 learn about the environment at The Brunel Shopping Centre

A group of our Y2 children visited Swindon's Brunel shopping centre to learn about how the centre manages its waste and its policy of *Reduce, Reuse & Recycle*.
