

English

Our key focus this term will be traditional tales.

During the term we will be reading a range of traditional tales, re-enacting them and talking about their similarities and differences. We will learn how to write character and setting descriptions and will develop our understanding of story language through retelling and re-writing traditional tales. Our work will culminate with our Year 1 play performance based upon traditional tales of The Three Little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood.

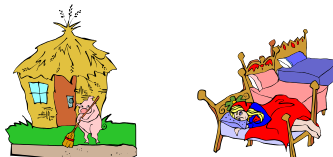
Science

This term we shall be investigating different materials. We shall be describing them and identifying their different properties. The children will be investigating the different materials used by the Three Little Pigs for building their houses.

Maths

This term we will develop our understanding of numbers and place value - reading, writing, counting and ordering numbers up to 100 and looking at what each digit is worth. The children will be learning how doubling and halving are related and will solve simple word problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will be comparing and measuring capacity and will use different vocabulary to describe position, movement and turning.

Design Technology

Our challenge this term will be to design, make and evaluate model houses featured in some of the traditional tales. As part of this challenge we will be investigating which cutting and fixing skills are best suited to different building materials. We will also use our cutting and fixing skills to create resources for our play.

Computing

This term we will be continuing to use I.C.T to support our learning across all the curriculum areas. We shall be using the Puppet Pals software on the i-pads to create simple puppet shows. The children will also be following and programming routes using the Blue-bots. As part of our work on internet safety we shall be looking at how we can keep ourselves safe when using electronic devices.

P.E.

During this term we shall be developing a range of gymnastic skills in P.E. We shall be creating different types of movements and linking them to make sequences.

R.E.

Our RE lessons will centre upon the stories about Jesus as a friend to others. The children will listen to stories about Jesus and talk about what friendship means.

Geography

This term we will be looking at maps, making our own maps with keys and looking at plans of buildings from above. We will also be learning about compass directions and how to use these.

Music

This term will see us focus on learning and performing the songs in our Year 1 play.

The children will learn, rehearse and perform songs to others. They will learn how to evaluate and improve upon their performance.

P.S.H.E.

Our P.S.H.E. work this term will be based around the theme of 'Dreams and Goals'. The children will be talking about how it feels to succeed at something and how to overcome obstacles to reach their goals.
