Impact of using PPSG 2016-17

All children access specialist PE teaching on a regular basis

All children in Reception to Y6 access outdoor learning activities

All children in Year 4, 5 and 6 have the opportunity to attend a residential visit (very few children do not take up this opportunity).

Gold award from SSP for attending all local competitions (four years in a row)

Swindon cross country champions year 3/4 girls winners, boys and girls cricket winners, reached semi-finals in all competitions

SRP represented Swindon for Boccia at South West Championships

Every child in year 6 represented the school at least three times

Greater range of sports clubs now available as requested by the school council: As well as the traditional sports we have offered cheerleading, dance, forest schools.
