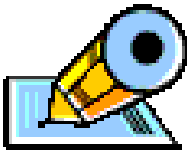


**Spellings:** Each child now has spellings to learn every week. Children have been grouped into either Ruby, Amber or Diamond groups. It is expected that they will learn all spellings in their group, but can have a go at more challenging ones if they want to.



### **Reading:**

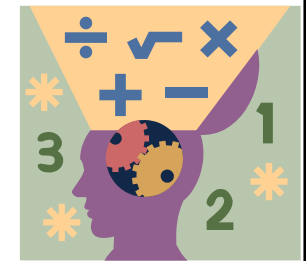
We have an expectation that children will read **five** times a week, usually with an adult. Adults need to initial or sign the reading record each time this happens.

### **Times tables:**

We will concentrate on the 6, 9 and 11 times tables. They should be known off by heart and not only in order. Please practice these facts with your children regularly. This doesn't necessarily need to be recorded in homework books.



### **Task 1:**

#### **Maths**

The children will practise their 6 times tables (for some children, they will practise their 3s). Children might show a poster, show some jottings in their homework book or learn them in a way that doesn't get recorded in their book. All children will be tested on ten questions on the due date to check their understanding.

### **Task 2:**

#### **English**

Linking with our work in class, we would like you to read a fairy tale/ traditional tale, preferably one we haven't read in class. We want you to note down which one you read and your likes and dislikes of the story.

All children will be asked to retell it to a partner at school.
