<u>English.</u>

In English the children will be researching Chocolate producers and using the information to produce a fact-file. Having visited The Richard Jefferies Museum, they will then focus on adventure stories inspired by the writing workshops they will take part in on the trip. Our target this term is to use expanded noun phrases e.g. the green, hairy caterpillar.

Information Communication Technology

In ICT this term the children will be working on programming using lbots and Kodu. They will continue to use 'Mathletics' and 'Times Tables Rockstars' in their Maths

<u>Music</u>

This term's music will focus on 'The Dragon Song' which highlights the importance of friendships and trust.

<u>P.E.</u>

This term the children will be developing their cricket skills in PE. They will learn about the rules, techniques, teamwork and the strategy of the game. They will also be having some gymnastic lessons which will focus upon balancing and travelling.

Science

In Science we will continue to explore different light sources and learn about reflection. We will also be experimenting with shadows and how these can be made larger or smaller. We will then move on to look at the life cycle of plants.

Term 5, Year 3 2018

We will be continuing with our 'Chocolate' topic until the beginning of May and will then start our new topic 'Childhood Adventures'.

History/Geography

The children will learn about the history of chocolate and fair trade. They will also research the history of chocolatiers such as Lindt and Cadbury's. In Geography lessons the children will produce 3D maps focussing on the local area.

<u>RE</u>

The children will be focussing on Hinduism and their belief that there is one God with many different aspects.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will be concentrating on our six times tables this term. Children can practise the multiplication and division facts, in and out of order using games. The children will also learn how to double and halve which is our termly target.

The children will be learning a new way of multiplying by using a grid method to help multiply larger numbers. Later in the term we will be focusing upon the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and converting different units of measure e.g. cm-m/ g-kg/ml-l.

Art/Design Technology

In Art/DT we will be designing and creating chocolate packaging using 3D nets.

<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE, the children will be focussing on 'Relationships'. This will focus upon the different relationships with have with our friends and family. We will be also be taking part in walk to school week and dementia awareness week.

Reminders

In Year 3 we expect the children to read at least five times every week at home. Reading records need to be brought in every Monday for Class 8 and every Friday for Class 7. Class 7 have PE on a Tuesday and Friday and Class 8 have PE on a Thursday.
