We will spend this term ensuring all children can achieve the early learning goal in number, shape, space and measure.

Number-

To count reliably to 20, place 0-20 in order, to say one more and one less than a given number, to add and subtract and to solve simple problems including doubling, halving and sharing.

Shape, Space and measure

To use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money. To recognise patterns. To talk about 2d and 3d shapes.
