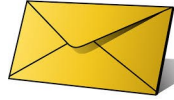

End of Year Sports News

Another year of sports at RLK has come to an end. This year every child in Year 6 has once again represented us on at least three occasions. We have participated in football, netball, rugby, hockey, cricket, rounders, cross-country, athletics, dodgeball and golf against other schools in competitions and festivals. The most important aim at RLK is sport for all; every child deserves a chance to participate and therefore they will have played for this school by the time they leave Year 6 regardless of their ability or experience. Not all schools adopt this philosophy.

However, we have still remained competitive and were Swindon Cricket Winners and Central League Football Champions, the former the seventh time in nine seasons we have topped the league. We also had top 4 finishes in every competition we entered meaning we qualified to represent our county in hockey, rugby, athletics and cricket. We also won our netball cluster for the first time. The children from Year 6 this year who have represented us at sport have been superb (as have children from across the whole school) and I hope they continue to carry on playing some of the sports they have tried at RLK at secondary school and in clubs outside of school for all the positive benefits sport brings, the most important being enjoyment.

Junior Good Citizen

Every year our Year 6 children go to a competition called the Junior Good Citizen held in Swindon. The children watch, listen and take part in relevant themes and scenarios set up by the Swindon Police. They are designed to test our children's knowledge and common sense in real life situations.
