In handwriting, the children will consolidate using horizontal and diagonal joins and use patterns to improve control. When reading and writing they will be focusing on poetry, information texts based on volcanos and fictional story writing based around the book 'Lost Happy Endings'. Weekly spellings are based around the year 3 coelling patterns that the children will be taught

Computing & e-safety

We will use Purple Mash to continue our work started last term on programming. Every term we teach e-safety and the children will use a class blog and discuss if everything we see online is true and can be believed. All children will also have a log-in for Mathletics, Times Tables Rockstars and Purple

<u>Music</u>

The children will be learning how to play the glockenspiel and using other instruments to develop simple performances. We will be learning basic instrumental skills by playing tunes in varying styles. Additionally, we will be introducing new musical vocabulary.
