Music

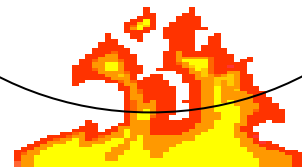
During this term we will be learning songs based around The Great Fire of London We will also be singing traditional Christmas songs
