

English

Year 3 will be writing instructions to become a Roman Gladiator, focussing on following verbal instructions, using prepositions and imperative verbs. Following on from our trip to the Corinium Museum, the children will use their experiences to write a first person recount. Our term will end with writing a Newspaper article and report.

Computing

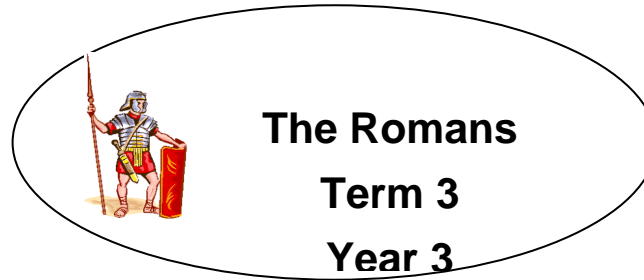
In computing, the children will be using Purple Mash to learn about spreadsheets and touch typing. They will handle data by creating spreadsheets and learning shortcuts within these. When learning to touch type, the children will be using different fingers to access various areas of the keyboard and learn to type with both hands comfortably. Safer internet day is also this term.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about measure and length including converting lengths between mm, cm and m as well as measuring, adding and subtracting lengths. The children will also be learning about Roman Numerals linked to Time before moving on to Shape and Angles.

Music

This term Year 3 will be listening to Reggae music and learning to read and understand notes to enable them to play the Glockenspiel.



The Romans Term 3 Year 3

History

During our Roman topic, children will be learning about the Roman Empire, including: The Roman Army and life of a soldier, Boudicca, Roman inventions such as roads and aqueducts, Roman houses and games. Year 3 will be going on a trip to the Corinium museum in Cirencester to learn about Roman discoveries such as mosaics.

P.E.

Class 7 and 8 will have their usual P.E lessons each week. Both classes will continue to have Mr Barnett on alternate Thursdays and Fridays. They will be learning to play Hockey and the basic skills needed to learn this sport, such as ball control, tackling, intercepting and special awareness. Swimming will also continue.

Science

This term the children will be looking at 'Animals including Humans'. We will be looking at nutrition and the different food groups and making healthy pizzas. We will also be investigating different types of animal skeletons, bones and muscles.

French

This term in French the children will be learning the days of the week, months of the year and dates within each year using their knowledge of the numbers 1-30.

DT

In DT, Year 3 will explore art and inventions from the Roman empire alongside designing, making and evaluating Shields and Mosaics throughout this topic.

PSHE

Our focus this term is 'Dreams and Goals'. We will look at challenges the children have faced, Goals they have for the future and new challenges they are looking forward to. We will also discuss how to overcome difficult challenges we are faced with and celebrate differences between us.

RE

In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity, focussing on the question 'Could Jesus heal people?'.

Reminders

We expect the children to read at least five times every week at home. Signed Reading records need to be brought in every Friday. The children will need to keep learning their weekly spellings and times tables which we will continue to test on a Friday. Our trip to the Corinium Museum is on 24th January and Swimming will end on 5th February.2019.
