E-SAFETY

Recently there have been some reports in the news about games, apps or sites children are accessing on the internet. We thought that it would be timely to give you some reminders of how you can support your child to use the internet responsibly and safely. Some useful hints for how to keep your child safe online include:

- Talk to your child about what games, apps and sites they are using—are they age appropriate?
- Ask your child to show you how they use these applications.
- Remind children that a 'friend' on a game is a stranger as they don't know the real person.
- Reassure your child that if someone asks them to do something they don't like online or in a game, they should talk to their parents or us at school.
