## <u>English</u>

The school will be celebrating World Book Day with the theme being 'Snow White'. Year 3 will be writing newspaper reports based on events in Snow white and Mount Vesuvius' eruption. Further in the term our narrative focus will be 'Gregory Cool' as a story from another culture and using this story as a basis for writing diaries, letters, explanations and persuasion as the

# <u>Music</u>

This term our focus in music will be our year group performance learning and singing the songs and choosing appropriate musical instruments to accompany the music.

## <u>P.E.</u>

Class 7 and 8 will return to usual P.E lessons in school each week. Both classes will continue to have Mr Barnett on alternate weeks. His lessons will focus on learning rugby and golf skills.

In addition, PE will link to the PSHE fitness challenge, including running the Golden Mile.

#### <u>DT</u>

In DT, Year 3 will be investigating joining materials with a focus on designing, making and evaluating Mosaics.

#### <u>Computing</u>

In computing, the children will be using Purple Mash to learn the skill of touch typing. The children will be using different fingers to access various areas of the keyboard and learn to type with both hands comfortably. Further in the term we will using email as a method of communication and understanding how to use it safely.

# Science

The children will be continuing to study the topic 'Animals including Humans'. We will be looking further into analysing nutrition and making healthy pizzas. We will also be building on our knowledge of the various types of skeletons and scientific names for bones by naming and explaining the functions of muscles.

## <u>PSHE</u>

Our focus this term is 'Healthy Me'. We will discuss healthy life choices, setting a fitness challenge, being safe both in the home and outside, including the safe use of drugs/medicines. Concluding with understanding how important it is to look after our bodies.

### <u>Reminders</u>

We expect the children to read at least five times every week at home. Signed Reading records need to be brought in every Friday. The children will need to keep learning their weekly spellings and times tables which we will continue to test on a Friday.

#### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will be learning 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Our focus will be revisiting addition, subtraction, multiplication, division using more formal methods of recording. Further in the term the children will be developing their fractions knowledge by calculating with fractions before studying the properties and angles of shapes.

## <u>History</u>

Continuing with our Roman topic, children will be learning about the Roman Empire, including: The Roman Army and life of a soldier, Boudicca, Roman inventions such as roads and aqueducts, Roman houses and games. Our DT link will include making mosaics.

### <u>French</u>

The theme this term in French is 'Portraits'. Key vocabulary will be colours, facial features and parts of the body. Before beginning to read and spell these words in French.

## <u>RE</u>

In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity, focussing on the question 'What is 'good' about Good Friday?'.
