### **English**

Our key focus this term will be traditional tales.

During the term we will be reading a range of traditional tales, re-enacting them and talking about their similarities and differences. We will learn how to write character and setting descriptions and will develop our understanding of story language through retelling and re-writing traditional tales. Our work will culminate with our Year 1 play performance based upon traditional tales of The Three Little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood.

## Design Technology

Our challenge this term will be to design, make and evaluate model houses featured in some of the traditional tales. As part of this challenge we will be investigating which cutting and fixing skills are best suited to different building materials. We will also use our cutting and fixing skills to create resources for our play.

## <u>P.E.</u>

Weekly PE sessions will focus upon continuing to develop simple gymnastic skills such as jumping, rolling and combining movements into sequences.

Initially our science will continue to focus on materials. The children will be investigating the different materials used by the Three Little Pigs for building their houses.

Later in the term we will focus upon weather and seasonal change. During the term we shall be looking at how the different environmental features change and

what happens with animals in Spring.

## R.E.

Our RE topic this term will focus upon the celebration of Easter and how Christians make preparations for Easter

#### Maths

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of place value. We will be using objects and number lines to compare and position numbers. The children will use their understanding of addition and subtraction to solve one step and missing number problems. During the term the children will continue to apply their understanding of multiplication and division to solve word problems. Our measurement focus will be based on time, with the children learning how to use clocks to measure time to the hour and half hour. As part of our problem solving work we will be using coins and notes to make amounts.

#### Computing

This term we will be continuing to use I.C.T to support our learning across all the curriculum areas. We shall be using the 2Go software on Purple Mash to move features around on the computer screen. The children will also be creating and debugging simple algorithms. As part of our work on internet safety we shall be looking at how we can keep ourselves safe when using electronic devices.

## <u>Geography</u>

This term we will be looking at maps, making our own maps with keys and looking at plans of buildings from above. We will also be learning about compass directions and how to use these.

## <u>P.S.H.E.</u>

Our P.S.H.E. work this term will be based around the theme of 'Healthy Me'. The children will identify and discuss what they need to do to lead healthy lives.
