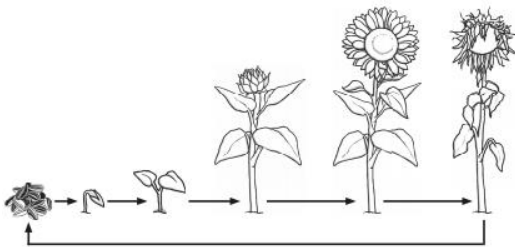


## Plants topic

Our science focus this term is plants. We will be learning about: the life cycle of plants, labelling parts of plants and functions of each of the plant parts, understanding how water is transported and finding out how plants pollenate.

### Task 1:

Create own way to represent the plant life cycle (eg: poster, leaflet, paper plate spinner, on-line webpage a piece of art work or a mini book) The main stages are germination, growing and flowering, pollination, fertilisation and seed dispersal.



### Task 2:

Roll and draw plant game (need a dice)

#### Roll and Draw Plant Game

To play this game you will need a 1-6 dice, a pencil and paper and a friend or family member to play with.

All parts are made up of different parts - roots, the stem, leaves and flowers.

The aim of this game is to draw a complete plant by rolling the dice.

You can draw a different part of your plant each time you roll a number.

- 1 = the roots
- 2 = the stem
- 3 = the leaves
- 4 = the petals
- 5 = the stem
- 6 = the stem and the leaves

If you roll a number you have already had, you should miss a turn.
