Please continue to hear your child to read at home and help them practise their keywords. It really does make a massive difference- thank you!



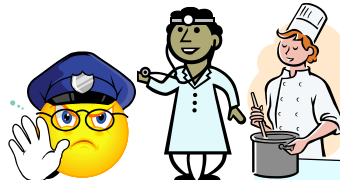
Our topics

Maths

Over the next two terms we will be consolidating all the concepts we have introduced over the year to ensure all children have the best chance to achieve the goal in number.

The early learning goal is 'Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or less than a given number. Using quantities and objects they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.

They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.'
