English

This term the children's writing will be linked to our Viking topic, using 'Viking Boy' by Tony Bradman as a stimulus. They will study different texts types including recounts, newspaper reports, myths and legends and stories from different points of view.

We will be having a particular focus on accurately using dialogue to advance action as well as looking at ways we can vary our sentences for impact.

We will be continuing to look at a variety of texts to support our guided reading ensuring we are using APE (answer, prove and explain) to respond to questions.

DT

Using our creative skills, we will be designing and making a Viking broth which would have helped provide them with strength whilst battling.

RE

French

In our French topic 'Then and Now', the children will be building on their knowledge of shopping vocabulary and learning to describe what someone is wearing.

PSHE

We will be looking at how to deal with worries; what it means to be a global citizen and how actions have consequences.

Science

This term, we will be learning about Living things and their habitats. The children will be studying Carl Linneaus who was responsible for developing classification. They will also learn how to classify different animals according to common features.

Computing
