English

We will be exploring many different genres based on a text written by Alexis Deacon, based on this text we will be writing a diary entry, setting descriptions and emotive letters. This will lead onto a book comparison later in the term. We will also continue to develop our year 2 writing techniques e.g. commas in a list, different sentence types and possessive apostrophes.

Design Technology

We will be designing and making a Beegu toy based on our English by looking at suitable materials, textures and colours. This may continue into term 4.

Maths

This term we will be recapping multiplication and division as well as moving on to fractions. We will be investigating unit and non-unit fraction of shapes and number. Later in the term, we will start to tell the time including o clock, half past, quarter to, quarter past and 5-minute intervals. It would be useful if children could practice telling the time at home too. In arithmetic, we will be partitioning 2 digit numbers in different ways and rounding to add and subtract near multiples of 10.

Computing

There are 5 areas of computing: programming, multimedia, technology in our lives, e-Safety and handling data. This term we will be using the computers and continuing to develop our spreadsheet skills including building basic formula.
