

English

We will be starting the term by reciting and writing poems based around food.

The children will also be writing a non-chronological report on the Human body. Further on in the term we will be reading a text from another culture 'Gregory Cool' and completing narrative and non-fiction pieces of writing based around this. Guided reading texts will be a non-fiction texts 'Bones' and 'Chocolate' and the short novel 'The Iron Man'.

Computing

In computing, the children will be using Purple Mash to learn the skill of touch-typing. The children will be using different fingers to access various areas of the keyboard and learn to type with both hands comfortably. Further in the term we will using email as a method of communication and understanding how to use it safely.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and division facts linked to Times Tables Rockstars. Our focus will be multiplication and division using formal methods of recording. Later on in the term the children will be investigating money. They will be identifying coins, comparing values and giving change.

Year 3 - Term 4

Amazing Animals



Music

This term our focus in music in Funk. Further in the term we will be revisiting reggae linked to the Gregory Cool story.

Science

The children will be studying the science topic 'Animals including Humans'. We will be looking at what nutrients and minerals foods contain and making healthy pizzas. They will also be identifying the various types of skeletons and using the scientific names for bones. In addition, we will be explaining the functions of muscles.

French

The theme this term in French is 'Portraits'.

Key vocabulary will include colours, facial features and parts of the body.

Art

Our artist study will focus on the work of abstract artist Wassily Kandinsky. Also linked to our science learning about bodies and skeletons we will also be creating drawings and 3D art linked to Alberto Giacometti.

PSHE

Our focus this term is 'Healthy Me'. We will discuss healthy life choices, setting a fitness challenge, being safe both in the home and outside, including the safe use of drugs/medicines. Concluding with understanding how important it is to look after our bodies.

In RE, we will continue to learn about Christianity, focussing on the question 'What is 'good' about Good Friday?'
