Don't forget to help your child learn some more words in their keywords book. The children need to learn these words on sight- no sounding out!

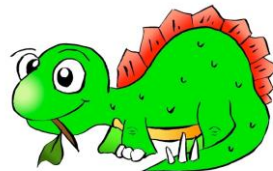
If you cannot find the book please come and ask for another one. 😊
