

Spellings:

New spellings are on the website. Please practise this weeks spellings, you can use the activity online to support this. Children have common exception words to keep practising as well. Remember, ten minutes a day is the best way to learn spellings



Reading:

We expect children to read **five** times a week, usually with an adult. **This week, see if you can choose a section of your book to rewrite using more interesting language and descriptions.** Children have reading comprehensions to complete twice a week.

Writing:

You will need to complete your research first. Then, create a fact file about your chosen 'Deadly 60' animal. You can do this on the computer or on paper. Remember to use punctuation and check your spelling.

Maths:

Recap your fractions learning. You will have looked at fractions in Year 3. Remember the denominator (bottom number) is how many pieces altogether and the numerator (top number) is how many are coloured. Have a go at the stained glass fractions sheet. There are 3 sheets which get harder, the answers are also there.

As always, children should practise their tables and remember they can log in and play on Times Tables Rock Stars!
