

Spellings:

Year 2 Term 5 spellings are on the school website as well as all the previous terms spellings and common exception words.

1. Create a word search or cross-word using this weeks spelling words.
2. Create an acrostic poem or riddle for each word.

Maths & Times tables:

Children should practise their 2, 5, 10 and 3 tables and matching division facts.

Complete at least 2 of the 3 maths activity sheets attached on the website. Remember you can use workings out.

Complete 1 star = Working towards Yr 2

2 star = Working at Expected Yr 2

3 star = Working at Greater Depth Yr 2

Purple Mash:

We have set topic activities on Purple Mash for children to complete during their time at home. These include games, quizzes. Log in and check '2Do'.

Reading:

We have an expectation that children will read **five** times a week, usually with an adult.

1. Look on the website for this weeks reading comprehension task.
2. Write a book review about one of the books you have read this week or last week. What did you like about it? Who is your favourite character? Why? What was the best part of the story? Explain your answers. Would you recommend the author? Why?

- Retell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. Include: opening, build up, problem, resolution and ending. Can you use expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, different sentence types and commas in a list. Remember full stops and capital letters.

Extra activities:

1. Phone a friend or family member and have a good chat with them. Maybe you could read them a story or a poem.
2. Write a set of instructions for children your age on how to keep safe in the sun. It is sun safety week. Create a poster for the instructions.
3. Design and make your own crown.
4. Make a fruit salad for you and your family. Do with an adult. Can you remember the knife skills we learnt in Term 1 of Year 2.
5. Complete parts of a tree worksheet. You may need to research the different parts of the tree. By the end you will know what and where the roots, trunk, leaves and branches are.
6. Sketch and label a tree you can see. Can you make it as realistic as possible?
