

Spellings:

Please practise this weeks spellings, you can use the activity online to support this. Children have common exception words to keep practising as well.



Remember, ten minutes a day is the best way to learn spellings

Reading:

We expect children to read **five** times a week, usually with an adult. **This week, become an illustrator and draw/paint something that has happened in your book. Maybe you could copy the style of Quentin Blake or Beatrix Potter.** Children have reading comprehensions to complete twice a week.

Writing:

Imagine you have gone on a safari to look for endangered animals. Write a diary entry using this starter:

Dear Diary,

I have to tell you about last night. As I lay still, willing sleep to come, I heard a rustling beside my tent...

Maths:

This week, children are learning about decimals on White Rose. The digit after the decimal place is tenths and hundredths are to the right of that. Have a go at the place value sheet on the school website to help understand decimal numbers.
