Welcome to Foundation Stage!

On Monday 12th October we will be sending home a phonic pack with the 5 sounds-(m,a,s,d,t) we have been learning in school. Please help your child practise saying and writing the sound. Bring the pack back the following Monday and we will put in the next 5 sounds.

Reading

Once all children are in school full-time we will be sending home reading books with your child. At first, these may just have pictures for you to look at and discuss or even make up your own story! We will send home a reading record with the books which will explain when they need to be returned to school and give suggestions about reading activities you can do together.
