We have had a little more information about the support that will be available to families who qualify for benefits based free school meals over the holidays. There will be a one-off supermarket voucher payment of £30 which we will process on your behalf. The office will email relevant families with more information once we have it. There is a letter entitled 'Pupil premium letter to parents' sent as an attachment with this newsletter with further details of eligibility. Please follow the link on the letter to apply if you think you might qualify for benefit based free school meal entitlement as it does give your child more than a free meal. It also means that the school can contribute towards trips and other events in school (when things get back to normal).

The school is beginning to feel a little more "Christmassy" with trees up and carols being learnt in sign language. We aren't doing cards and presents this year, but we are doing our Christmas service remotely with each class recording their contribution so that we can all watch it on the last day.

As you may be aware, The Robert Le Kyng Supporters are currently not able to hold any of the usual events that enable us to fundraise, so we are looking for alternative ways to raise money.

As a charity, the RLK Supporters have recently signed up with a scheme which enables us to raise funds from purchases made through Amazon. It works in a similar way to other schemes and doesn't involve any additional cost to those who are purchasing. The donation to the RLK Supporters comes from an Amazon community fund. It is easy to set up.

To register to donate to the RLK Supporters' fund while purchasing, follow these instructions. The order may be different depending on the device you register on.

- 1. Access the Amazon website through smile.amazon.co.uk
- Click on 'Get started'
- 3. Sign in to your Amazon account in the usual way (if not automatically signed in), e.g. email address and password
- 4. Type in 'Robert Le Kyng School Supporters' to search charity and click 'select' It will ask you to tick a box to say you understand that purchases will need to be made via smile.amazon.co.uk for donations to be sent to the charity.

Each time you shop with Smile.amazon.co.uk they will automatically make a donation to the RLK Supporters' charity. You do not need to select the charity each time. If at any time you wish to donate to a different charity, click on 'Change charity' and you can search for a different charity to support.

When the Supporters' fund receives the donations they will appear as completely anonymous. We receive no information about the accounts from where purchases have been made.

Please pass this information onto any family or friends who you feel would like to help the RLK Supporters in their fundraising.
