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Book Fair and World Book Day vouchers

Sadly, we have had to cancel the Scholastic Book Fair which would have been coming early in March. We know how disappointing this is for the children, especially as they enjoy using the World Book Day tokens to put towards the cost of a book. After speaking with the Book Fair team at Scholastic, we have arranged to set up an online Book Fair, around the time the Fair would normally be visiting. Although it won't be quite the same, you will be able to view and order books via the Scholastic website.

Thursday 4th March is World Book Day. Normally, the children would be receiving paper versions of the World Book Day vouchers from school. This year the children will get their voucher electronically. We will send out further information about how to access the voucher after half term. Although the voucher can't be used to purchase books online, you will be able to use them at many of the local supermarkets, either towards the cost of a children's book or in exchange for one of the specially written World Day books.

COVID UPDATE If your child is attending keyworker school and develops symptoms within 48hrs of finishing school today <u>and</u> subsequently has a positive test (or has a non-symptomatic positive test within 48hrs) please contact the school in the normal way via

- Mark the subject line "Covid—URGENT"
- Give your child's name and class
- The date the symptoms started, date of the test and result.

This account will only be monitored for Covid related correspondence.

Obviously, if you suspect that your child, or a member of your family has Covid-19, the whole household should isolate until the test results are known as usual.

<u>If</u> we have notification that there has been a positive case in your child's bubble, we will inform you of this through Parentmail, so please do keep checking this throughout the break.

- Access the Amazon website through smile.amazon.co.uk
- Click on 'Get started'
- Sign in to your Amazon account in the usual way (if not automatically signed in), e.g. email address and password
- Type in 'Robert Le Kyng School Supporters' to search charity and click 'select'
- It will ask you to tick a box to say you understand that purchases will need to be made via smile.amazon.co.uk for donations to be sent to the charity.

Each time you shop with Smile.amazon.co.uk they will automatically make a donation to the RLK Supporters' charity.

How our fundraising has helped

As a result of our fundraising over the last few years, we have been able to support the school in financing several projects.
