




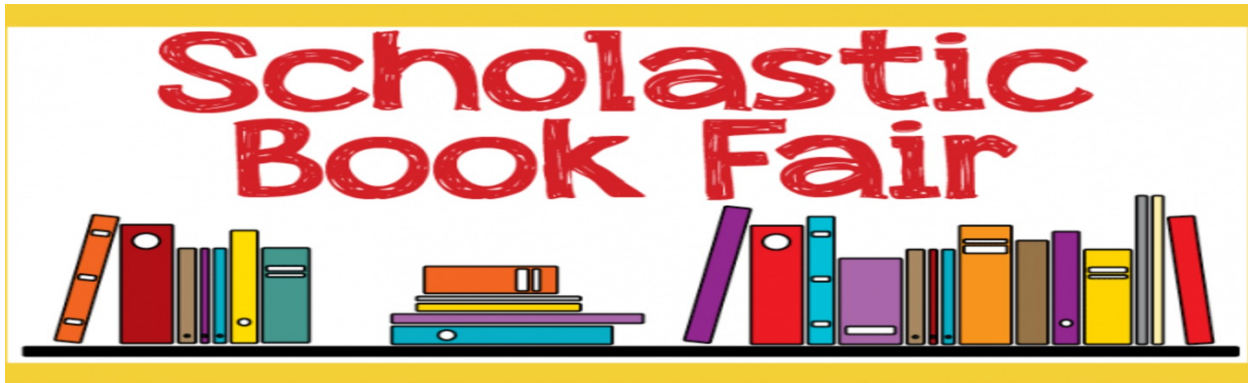

You can access the Book Fair/Club page on the Scholastic website and then browse the different selections of books. You can order and pay for any books you wish to purchase. Any books that you order will be sent to the school by Scholastic and then passed onto you. You will also be able to use your child's World Book Day voucher to save £1 off the price of a book costing £2.99 or more. **The Book Fair/Club will be 'open' on the Scholastic website until Monday March 22nd.** The school will still benefit from the commission from every book that is sold. 1. Browse the different categories to look at the selection of books available.
 2. To purchase a book click on the 'buy' tab underneath the book of your choice.
 3. The book(s) purchased will be added to your 'basket'.
 4. When you have finished shopping, click on 'checkout' and follow the step by step instructions to complete your purchase.
