Parents Consultation Meetings

Tuesday 25th May—3.30pm to 5.30pm (Class 4 only)

This term we will be holding online parent consultation meetings over Microsoft Teams. While it is likely that the guidance will have changed by that point and that we could meet up to 6 people indoors, it is almost certain that we would go over this number in waiting areas. It would also mean that the teachers would be exposed to a lot of “contacts” over the course of the evening.

We will use the usual process to book a 10-minute slot using Parentmail. You will then be sent a link to a Microsoft Teams meeting. You can download the Teams App free from your usual providers. When the time comes for your meeting, use the link you have been sent to access the meeting. This will put you into the waiting room and the teacher will be informed that you are waiting. Once the teacher has finished the meeting before you and the previous parents have left the meeting, the teacher will let you in. Please be patient if you are not immediately let into the meeting.

Look out for the booking email over Parentmail in the next couple of weeks.
