## Covid update

**If a child has symptoms** they will be asked to isolate and take a PCR test. This is going to be our main defence against any spread of the virus in school, so we will be very strict about asking parents to take a child for a test even if they only have very mild symptoms. We still require parents to report a positive lateral flow test( LFT) to us and following this to book a PCR test for your child. If the PCR is positive NHS Track & Trace will take over responsibility for tracking close contacts and these people will be asked to take a PCR test.

**Cleaning/ventilation:** We will still expect children to wash their hands frequently and will clean 'touchpoints' around the school. Windows and doors will be left open to ventilate rooms. These are common sense measures that should not get in the way of the children's education.

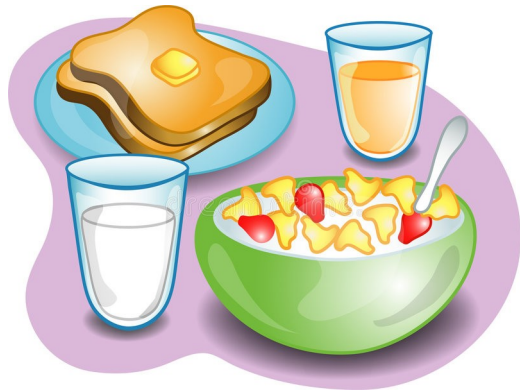

Booking/paying in advance for the next term attracts a 20% discount on the price.

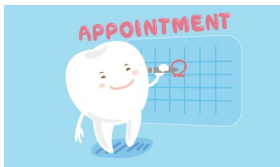


## Welcome New Governors at RLK
