Covid update

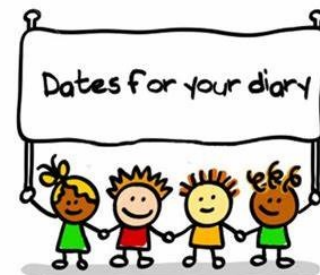
We still need to be very aware that Covid 19 is still in our community. If your child has symptoms please book a PCR test for them and inform school of the results. If your child develops symptoms whilst at school we will ask you to collect your child and take them for a PCR test. This is going to be our main defence against any spread of the virus in school, so we will be very strict about asking parents to take a child for a test even if they only have very mild symptoms. We still require parents to report a positive lateral flow test (LFT) to us and following this to book a PCR test for your child. If the PCR is positive NHS Track & Trace will take over responsibility for tracking close contacts and these people will be asked to take a PCR test.

Are you a parent or grandparent who can spare some time to help at school events and trips?

If so, please contact the school office if you would like further information.



As a volunteer in school, we would need to carry out a DBS check and ask for two references. The necessary forms can be collected from the school office.
