

English

Children will begin this term by writing a first person narrative about an alien landing, they will use a text by Pie Corbett as inspiration. During this piece, children will practise using dialogue effectively and create atmosphere through their setting descriptions.

Our writing will link to our topic of earthquakes, children will imagine what it is like to experience an earthquake and write a diary entry. They will also write a newspaper report of a major earthquake. Here they will practise

Spellings

Children will learn the following spelling rules: words ending '-ant', '-ance', '-ent', '-ence', '-able', '-ible', '-ably' and '-ibly' Children

PSHE

Our focus will be 'Celebrating Differences', we will learn about how important it is to show respect for our own, and different cultures and

Music

We will be doing 'Classroom Jazz' in music. Children will get the opportunity to play instruments and will be able to improvise with these instruments

P.E.

This term, children will be practising skills related to games such as attacking and defending. They will then be applying these

Science

This term, children will be learning about the relative size, shape and movement of the Earth and moon as well as the importance of the Sun. Investigations will include looking at how shadows change over the course of a day and understanding how time



Geography

This term, children will be learning what earthquakes are and how they occur. They will learn about the structure of the Earth, tectonic plates and how they move. In order to understand how earthquakes impact people, we will look at the most dangerous factors of earthquakes. As well as this, we will

Maths

This term we will be looking at Geometry, Addition and Subtraction. The children will be identifying 3D shapes such as cubes, cuboids, prisms and pyramids from their nets. Children will also be adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers using efficient methods, progressing further by using decimal numbers.

It is expected that children know their multiplication and division facts up to 12 x12

This term, children will be learning about online safety. This will include their responsibilities online, protecting their privacy, how to cite sources and

Children will be investigating the different accounts of the Christmas story by different people in the Bible to address the similarities and

We will be focussing on Alma Thomas and her work on 'Space Art'. Children will have the opportunity to explore different materials and techniques to
