Last year the RLK Supporters signed up with a scheme which enables us to raise funds from purchases made through Amazon. As Christmas approaches, we thought it would be an ideal opportunity to remind you about it works. It is similar to other schemes and doesn't involve any additional cost to those who are purchasing. The donation to the RLK Supporters comes from an Amazon community fund. Since signing up last year, the RLK Supporters have already received several donations from the fund. If you have not done so already, it is easy to set up.

To register to donate to the RLK Supporters' fund while purchasing, follow these instructions. The order may be different depending on the device you register on.

- Access the Amazon website through smile.amazon.co.uk
- Click on 'Get started'
- Sign in to your Amazon account in the usual way (if not automatically signed in), e.g. email address and password
- Type in 'Robert Le Kyng School Supporters' to search charity and click 'select' It will ask you to tick a box to say you understand that purchases will need to be made via smile.amazon.co.uk for donations to be sent to the charity.

Each time you shop with Smile.amazon.co.uk they will automatically make a donation to the RLK Supporters' charity. You do not need to select the charity each time. If at any time you wish to donate to a different charity, click on 'Change charity' and you can search for a different charity to support.

When the RLK Supporters' fund receives the donations they will appear as completely anonymous. We receive no information about the accounts from where purchases have been made.

Please pass this information onto any family or friends who you feel would like to help the RLK Supporters in their fundraising.



Can we please ask that if your child brings a packed lunch that they have healthy items in it. You might want to include a sandwich or wrap a piece of fruit or raw vegetable a yoghurt or jelly

Covid update

If your child has Covid symptoms (ie, cough, temperature, loss or a change to taste or smell) please book a PCR test for them and inform school of the results. If they test **negative** for COVID-19 but have had a fever, they should still wait a further 24 hours post fever to come back into school. If your child is **asymptomatic** and has taken a PCR because a member of the household has tested positive, we require a daily LFT to be undertaken before arriving at school in an attempt to minimise Covid transmission between classmates and staff.

Colds and other non-Covid symptoms are circulating but in the first instance persistent coughs and high temperatures should be treated as possible COVID-19 and trigger isolation and testing.

If your child develops symptoms whilst at school we will ask you to collect your child and take them for a PCR test. This is going to be our main defence against any spread of the virus in school, so we will be very strict about asking parents to take a child for a test even if they only have very mild symptoms. We still require parents to report a positive lateral flow test (LFT) to us and following this to book a PCR test for your child.
