- Discuss issues and concerns and help develop strategies to help you, your child and your family around behaviour management, sleep routines and positive parenting
- Suggest services and other agencies available who could help and support you in a range of situations
- Refer to food banks and other organisations that provide practical support
- Aid and encourage good attendance

We would encourage all parents/carers to get in touch, especially to let the school know about anything important that is happening at home. We want our children to be settled and ready to learn and will support you with any home situation that may affect your children's ability to do this.

## Covid update

After talking at length with Public Health this week, we have been made aware that **headaches and tummy upsets are early common symptoms in children** with the Omicron variant of Covid 19. Please monitor your child for any symptoms and do not send them in if they are unwell.

We would be grateful if as many children as possible could complete a lateral flow test at the start of each week if they are able to and if symptomatic please follow up with a PCR. If a member of the household receives a positive result, we would ask you to test your child daily for 7 days. We understand this is not possible for all children but the more children that do, the greater chance we have of minimising infection within the school.
