

Reading

This term, pupils will be split into two groups so that they can be provided with targeted support in their reading.

Group 1 will continue reading the phonically decodable Little Wandle books. These will be changed by an adult every Friday.

Group 2 will be bringing home books to support their comprehension skills. These can be changed independently whenever they have been read.

Reading should be recorded with the date and a comment/signature from an adult in your child's yellow reading record. Please ensure reading books and reading records are in school **every day**.
