Reading and Library Books

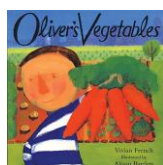
We will send reading and library books home on a **Friday** once we have practised reading them in The Huddle. Please ensure your child has their book in their bag on a **Friday**.

Trips out

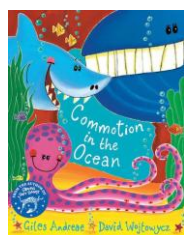

Within the Huddle our topic focuses will be based on different stories to help develop the children's language and understanding.

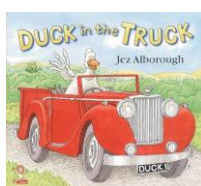
Our current topic is "**Oliver's Vegetables**" and will be based around healthy eating.
