Tricky words and reading

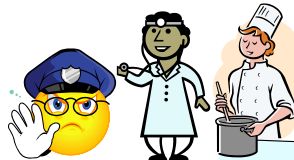
Please continue to hear your child read at home and help them practise their tricky words. It really does make a massive difference- thank you!
